

#### Revolution of the Heart

July 4th. brings to mind annual joyous traditions like grilling out, parades, fireworks, apple pie, and remembering great American heroes who founded our country in 1776. The opening words of our Declaration of Independence reverberate down through history, "When in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one People to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with one another."

Our American Revolution was a defining moment in US history. We should never forget it, and never repeat it. I'm glad we focus on celebrating our Nation on July 4th. One very personal lesson we can take from our past is that a revolution is a forcible overthrow of a government or social order, in favor of a new system. We think of revolutions as war on a national scale, but they can also take place on a personal level.

Revolution is an appropriate description of our coming to Christ. Did you ever think about your faith as the fruits of a personal revolution? The weapons include public humiliation, a whip, a cross, and nails, and an empty tomb. The field of battle is an individual's mind, heart, and will. This kind of revolution is the struggle over who controls our lives. The decisive blow in this war came when Jesus died on a cross, and rose from the dead. The only thing left for us to do, now that the fighting is over, is to decide which side we will follow. Who will rule our hearts?

When Jesus rules our lives we're transformed. 2 Corinthians 3:18 says, "18 And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit."

With Jesus as Lord, we have spiritual refreshment as evidence our sins have been wiped out. Acts 3:19 says, "19 Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord." Jesus actually makes us into new creations when He is Lord. 2 Corinthians 5:17 tells us, "17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" The very nice thing about our Lord Jesus Christ is that we can celebrate his indestructible kingdom for eternity as we walk in faith, trusting on him all the way.

I hope you will enjoy Independence Day and have a Happy Summer.




